

Depart USA July 16 for overnight flight. Detailed Trip Tips coming soon by email to those that booked with all you need to know.

DAY 1 – July 17 - SPLIT (D)

The trip officially starts today at Split airport. We will meet our guide at the Split airport and head to the Hotel Ora near Split harbor. Check-in is from 2pm. We will spend the afternoon touring the beautiful historic town of Split. Split is listed as a UNESCO World Heritage site and boasts an abundance of classic Roman architecture, which includes the splendid Diocletian Palace where Game of Thrones Queen Daenerys trained her 3 dragons.

We visit Klis Fortress, where Daenerys seized the city of Meereen, freeing the slaves from their masters. You will explore a small village, Zrnovnica, where Missandei, Daenerys's handmaid and interpreter had her bathing scene.

Tonight, your week's GoT island-hopping will begin with the Welcome meet and greet cocktail reception on board the Memories. You will be introduced to the Cruise Director, Captain and crew and fellow passengers.

DAY 2 – July 18 - SPLIT - SIBENIK - KRKA NATIONAL PARK (B, L)

In the morning, we will board the MS Memories and set sail for the medieval city of Sibenik, founded over 1000 years ago. After arriving, we'll make our way to the stunning Krka Waterfalls National Park, a true phenomenon of nature. Get your cameras ready to admire the beautiful waterfalls and stroll along pathways winding through the lush flora with a refreshing swim opportunity in front of stunning Skradinski Buk waterfall. Return to Sibenik where you can meander through the labyrinth of backstreets to discover the hidden gems such as the UNESCO listed St John's Church.

By day there's plenty of watersports to enjoy in the clear waters of the Adriatic. The harbors of these towns are too small for big ships and so delightful to explore on own. Your evening is free to enjoy this enchanting town.

DAY 3 – July 19 - SIBENIK - VIS (B, L, T)

We sail in the morning on towards the peaceful island of Vis, which was once a strategic Yugoslav naval base. Due to the island's seclusion and isolation, Vis has a unique charm that typifies 'the Mediterranean as it once was'. It is also famed as the setting for the hit movie, Mama Mia 2. We have a fantastic wine-tasting experience at a family winery where you will sample some of the delicious local wines. You can also visit the fascinating City museum or enjoy a leisurely stroll whilst enjoying the views of the elegant Villae Rusticae, situated

along the waterfront. Enjoy your time here during the late afternoon and evening, or you can choose to spend your evening aboard the Memories.

DAY 4 – July 20 - VIS – HVAR (B, L)

We continue cruising towards the cosmopolitan island of Hvar which is renowned for its stunning and fragrant fields of lavender as well as its beaches and wineries. On route, we head to Bisevo to explore the breathtaking Blue Cave. This is truly a natural marvel, a sea grotto of illuminated light. Once we arrive in Hvar, we will take our guided walking tour to experience the town's most popular landmarks, including the Renaissance cathedral with its original tower. The town fort overlooks the harbor and offers stunning scenic views of the Pakleni islands. Hvar also has a large mix of excellent restaurants, bars and cafes to sample.

Optional Experience – We can arrange a traditional Croatian dinner in a unique abandoned village. Including 2 courses with a glass of wine.

DAY 5 – July 21 - HVAR – KORČULA (B, L, D)

We head on to the striking island of Korčula, which is best known as the birthplace of the famous explorer Marco Polo. Admire the stunning secluded bays en route. Once we arrive in Korčula, we set out immediately for a guided tour of this charming Old Town. The small fortified town, ruled by Venetians in the past, has an ingenious layout in the shape of a fishbone, both to prevent the strong winds from chilling the houses in winter, and to increase the air circulation in the summer.

Tonight we have a traditional village evening arranged with authentic local entertainment!

DAY 6 – July 22 - KORČULA - MLJET – SLANO/ STON (B, L, T, D)

We set sail early this morning for the tranquil and stunning Mljet National Park. On arrival, we join our local cycle guide for a relaxed-paced two-wheeled adventure around the famous salt lakes. We continue to the village of Slano, situated on the mainland. It is a peaceful traditional fishermen's village and the entrance point to Ston, another fortified small village that is famous for its oysters. After exploring the town's medieval ramparts, we will take you to an oyster farm, where you will have the opportunity to sample fresh oysters, washed down with the local brandy liquor.

DAY 7 – July 23 - SLANO - DUBROVNIK (B, L, D)

On the final day of our cruise, we make an early departure to Dubrovnik. This ancient city boasts many historical buildings that date back to the time of the old Dubrovnik Republic. We will have an extensive guided walking tour of this magnificent city and you will enjoy magnificent, panoramic scenic views of the ancient city and beautiful Elaphiti Islands. We will explore all of the main sites, used on the GoT series, including the Meineeta Tower, the highest point of the city, filmed when Daenerys and Jorah Mormont attempted to enter the House of the Undying as Daenerys attempts to retrieve her stolen dragons.

Tonight, will be one of the highlights, the Farewell Party set in the heart of the Kings Landing, at the Bokar Fortress. A fun evening, full of surprises!

DAY 8 – July 24 - Day trip to Montenegro

With a population of a bigger European city suburb (650,000), Montenegro is an enchanting little country full of extreme geographical diversities. Great mountains with snow peaks, steep fiord-like hills almost vertically diving into the Adriatic Sea, mountain lakes full of fish, mystical monasteries carved in the solid rock, sandy and sunny beaches that go on for miles alongside the coast... this is Montenegro. Enjoy a guided tour of this enchanting country visiting the UNESCO protected town of Kotor, the pristine picture-perfect time of Perast and Our Lady of the Rocks island.

DAY 9 - JULY 25 - -

After breakfast and checking off the ship, we head to the charming small country of Montenegro. Montenegro may be one of the smallest countries in Europe but is undeniably large in every other way – from its dramatic vistas and endless coastline to its magnificently preserved architecture. The atmospheric, walled old city of Kotor was built between the 12th and 14th centuries.

Enjoy a guided tour of the old town of Kotor, a UNESCO Site. The sheltered bay for the chic yachting set and enchants visitors with so much to do here. We take a stroll through its atmospheric and historic streets that Napoleon once walked, set within a truly stunning backdrop. It is a medieval maze of winding streets and squares, Romanesque churches, the dazzling cathedral, and Venetian palaces and pillories. Further around the bay, the baroque town of Perast is the site of a famous victory against the Ottomans. We return to Dubrovnik and check into our hotel for the final night of this GoT Adventure.

Overnight: Dubrovnik - Hotel Lapad. Great hotel with pool, beach and airport shuttle.

DAY 10 - JULY 26 -

After breakfast, it is time to say goodbye to all the fellow GoT enthusiasts after an incredible adventure and transfer to the airport for our flights home.
